Home is where the Hart is ... in reality, home is where the Harts live, and also where the art lives

ROM the moment the wide front entry gate, with its glass embossed signature dragonflies, opens you know you've arrived at the home of an artist.

And not just any artist ... this is the home of David Hart, his wife Christine and their three children Jake, Chloe and Harry.

"The front gate probably took more time to plan than anything else in the house," admits David.

"Because it is the front gate, it has to make a statement. I wanted people to know they had arrived at the home of an artist."

Once inside, though, there is no doubt.

On the walls hang paintings by David himself, by his father Pro and from other well-known artists including Dickerson, Ron Davis and David Boyd.

David explains how a simple "renovation" resulted in what is really a new home.

"We only left the slab, one wall, the garage

and a few pieces of timber," he says.
"We had bought a few different blocks of land with the idea of building a new home but, when it came down to it, we liked being here because it is so convenient and we decided to renovate instead."

The new home is a world away from its brick replica colonial-style predecessor, but still melds with the natural rural landscape of
